



## Playground upgrade

Elsternwick Park South Playground (South) is currently in the design phase and is scheduled to be upgraded in 2018/19.

Designs are being finalised on the \$180,000 playground, with construction expected to be completed by early 2019.

Elsternwick Park South Playground (North) is scheduled to be replaced in 2021/22. As this is a regional playground, \$650,000 has been allocated to upgrade this playground. Design and consultation are expected to commence in 2020.

As part of the redevelopment of Elsternwick Park, the playground adjacent to Oval 2 will be removed.

# The future of Elsternwick Park



## Investment in Elsternwick Park

Elsternwick Park is a significant park in Bayside's north, providing valuable open space and recreational facilities for residents and visitors.

Bayside City Council is making a significant investment in upgrades at Elsternwick Park over the coming years, including transforming the former golf course site into an environmentally-focussed park.



### What's happening?

#### 30 June 2018

Elsternwick Golf Course will close and golf will cease at the site.

#### From 1 July 2018

Council will undertake works to make the former golf course safe for public access.

Park will be open to the public, dogs must be on-leash at all times.

#### Late 2018/19

Master planning process commences to develop an environmentally-focussed reserve in the area of Elsternwick Park North.

## Returning golf course to public open space

### Elsternwick Golf Course Closure

Elsternwick Golf Course will cease activities on 30 June and the site will be returned to Council management.

Some areas of the park will be temporarily closed while Council undertakes works to make the former golf course safe and accessible. Members of the public are reminded to take care when around these areas.

The former golf course site will be open as public parkland for recreational use including; picnics, running, walking and other activities. Dogs must be on-leash at all times.

In late 2018-early 2019, Council will commence the master planning process to develop the former golf course site into an environmentally-focussed park.

Public consultation will be undertaken during the master planning process to better understand the needs of the community.

## Improving facilities

### Elsternwick Park South Public Toilet

As part of our Capital Works program we are investing \$130,000 in replacing the Elsternwick Park South toilet block.

Works will involve the demolition of the existing toilet block and the construction of a new toilet block with all abilities access.

A temporary toilet will be available for use during the construction period from June – July 2018.

## Oval redevelopment

### Oval 1

Council has partnered with the Victorian Government, Victorian Amateur Football Association, AFL, AFL Victoria and Old Melburnians Football Club to redevelop the site.

The \$6.4 million redevelopment will deliver a new two-storey pavilion and improved oval.

The oval was completed in April and the pavilion was completed in June.

### Oval 2

Council has invested \$1.1 million in upgrading the oval as part of its commitment to improving facilities at Bayside sportsgrounds.

The upgrades include a new pavilion and cricket nets, installation of lighting and improvements to the oval playing surface.
